

ACTIVE AND PASSIVE VOICE

Voice refers to the relationship between the subject and the action of a sentence.

ACTIVE

In **active voice**, the subject performs the action.

Example: I love you.

PASSIVE

In **passive voice**, the subject receives the action.

Example: I am loved.

EXAMPLES

	ACTIVE	PASSIVE
Present simple	Wolves hunt sheep.	Sheep are hunted by wolves.
Past simple	Mark repaired my computer.	My computer was repaired.
Be going to	Jerry is going to pick you up.	You are going to be picked up by Jerry.
Modals	You should help her.	She should be helped.

In passive voice, the agent that performs the action can be omitted.
