Do homework	You need to do your homework before you go out.
Do business	We prefer to do business with reliable companies.
Do a favour	Could you do me a favour, please?
Do your best	I did my best, but I didn't succeed.
Do the dishes	Is it my turn to do the dishes tonight?
Do exercise	He needs to do more exercise to stay healthy.
Do the laundry	I can't go with you now. I have to do the laundry.
Do research	I'm doing research on galaxy evolution.
Do the cooking	He always does the cooking on Sundays.
Do a job	He did a great job saving the little girl from drowning.
Do damage	The storm did a lot of damage to the roof.
Do harm	Smoking can do serious harm to your health.
Do a service	Sir Winston Churchill was a hero. He did a great service to his country.
Do a good deed	I feel satisfied because I have done a good deed.
Do an experiment	I'm doing a social experiment to understand people's reaction to danger.
Do something	Tomorrow is Sarah's birthday. We should do something special for her.
Do justice	I think the last FIFA award didn't do justice to those who deserved it the most.
Do paperwork	I hate my job. I didn't join the police service to do paperwork.
Do the washing up	Can you do the washing up and I do the laundry?
Do the right thing	You did the right thing to tell her the truth.
