Get dressed	Hurry up and get dressed, we're late!

Get the job done	We need to get the job done by the end of the day.
Get the hang of something	It may seem difficult at first, but you'll eventually get the hang of it.
Get hold of	I have been trying to get hold of him the whole day.
Get an award	He got an award for his bravery.
Get a loan	They got a loan to buy a new house.
Get a passport	You need to get a passport before travelling abroad.
Get revenge	He wanted to get revenge after somebody killed his brother.
Get a surprise	She got a surprise party for her birthday.
Get a suntan	I'll try to find a shady spot. I don't want to get a suntan.
