Type	If clause	Main clause	Use
Type 0	If + Present simple	Present simple	General truths or facts, i.e., situations that are always true.
Type 1	If + Simple present	Simple future	Real or likely situations in the future and their probable consequences.
Type 2	If + Simple past	Present conditional or present continuous conditional	Unreal or hypothetical situations in the present or future.
Type 3	If + Past perfect	Perfect conditional	Hypothetical situations in the past and their imagined (past) consequences.
Mixed type	If + Past perfect or past simple	Present conditional or perfect conditional	Past hypothetical conditions and their consequences in the present.
