Conjunctive adverb	Function/Purpose	Example sentence
however	to show contrast	I like tea; however , my brother prefers coffee.
therefore	to indicate consequence or result	She studied hard; therefore , she passed her exams.
moreover	to add information	It was raining heavily; moreover , the wind was strong.
furthermore	to add more information or emphasis	He's smart; furthermore , he's very hardworking.
nevertheless	to show contrast	It was cold; nevertheless , we went swimming.
meanwhile	to show events happening simultaneously	She cooked dinner; meanwhile , he set the table.
otherwise	to indicate a condition or consequence	Finish your homework; otherwise , you can't watch TV.
indeed	to emphasise or confirm	The task was difficult; indeed , it seemed impossible.
consequently	to show cause and effect	He missed the bus; consequently , he arrived late.
instead	to show an alternative	She didn't go to Paris; instead , she visited Rome.
