Coordinating conjunction	Function / Usage	Example sentence
For	Explains reason or purpose (similar to "because")	She stayed home, for she was feeling ill.
And	Adds one element to another; addition	I bought apples and oranges.
Nor	Presents an additional negative idea	She didn't know what to do, nor did I.
But	Shows contrast or an exception	She is small but strong.
Or	Presents an alternative or choice	Would you like tea or coffee?
Yet	Introduces a contrast; similar to "but"	It was raining, yet they went for a walk.
So	Shows result or effect	It was late, so they decided to go home.
