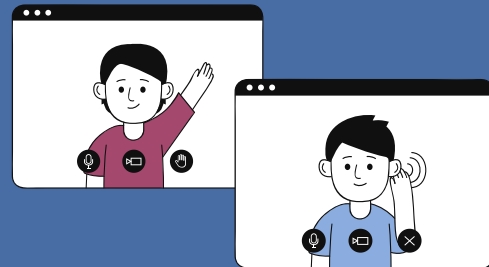


FUTURE PERFECT CONTINUOUS
