

FUTURE PERFECT CONTINUOUS

FUNCTION

The future perfect continuous tense expresses actions that will be in progress until a point of time in the future.

SUBJECT	+ WILL HAVE BEEN	+ PRESENT PARTICIPLE
I/He/She/It/ We/You/ They	will have been	working

EXAMPLES

- I will have been married for 10 years next month.
- When we arrive in Paris, we will have been driving for 8 hours.
- By noon, she will have been singing for 3 hours.
