

# THE FUTURE PERFECT SIMPLE

Form	Structure	Example
Positive (+)	subject + will have + past participle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• I will have eaten lunch by 1 p.m.</li><li>• By the time I turn 40, I will have saved enough money to buy a house.</li></ul>
Negative (-)	subject + will not have + past participle	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• She will not have finished her report by then.</li><li>• The mechanics will not have fixed the car before our trip.</li></ul>
Question (?)	will + subject + have + past participle?	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Will she have graduated by June?</li><li>• Will you have finished your homework by the end of the day?</li></ul>
Common time expressions	by / by the time / by tomorrow / by next week / by 7 o'clock / before
