TENSE	Form	Use	EXAMPLES
Past simple	verb + -ed (regular) / 2nd form (irregular)	Describes completed actions in the past.	<ul> <li>She went to the market and bought some fruit.</li> </ul>
Past continuous	was/were + verb + -ing	Describes actions in progress at a specific time in the past.	<ul> <li>She was reading a book when I arrived.</li> </ul>
Past perfect	had + past participle	Describes an action that happened before another action in the past.	<ul> <li>They had already finished dinner before I arrived.</li> </ul>
Past perfect continuous	had been + verb + -ing	Describes an action that was happening over time before another past action.	<ul> <li>They had been waiting for an hour before the bus arrived.</li> </ul>
