Form	Function / Usage	Structure	Example Sentence
Will + infinitive	Describes future actions, predictions, promises, or repetitive habits in the present time.	Subject + will + base verb	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• It's getting cold, I will close the window.• Every day, she will take the dog for a walk.
Would + infinitive	Describes past habits or imagined situations	Subject + would + base verb	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• When we were kids, we would play outside all day.• If I won the lottery, I would buy a house.
Used to + infinitive	Describes past habits or situations that no longer happen	Subject + used to + base verb	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• I used to live in Paris when I was a child.• I used to drink when I was young.
